- (3) Scope of the organization : Will be whole India.
- (4) Objectives of the organization : The purposes of this trust shall be as follows.

(a) Educational Objectives:

- 1) To spread public education for the intellectual, moral, physical and moral development of the whole organization.

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- 3) Also, helping the students who are in need of notebooks, books, guides etc. from the institution and providing scholarships to the students and giving prizes to the students, helping the needy students who want to pursue higher studies within the limits of the trust. To establish, run and maintain reading rooms and to publish and conduct monthly, quarterly, fortnightly magazines, literature for the overall development of students.

- 4) To conduct, maintain and set up home industries, computer classes, typing classes, stitching classes, Bharata-knitting classes and provide free training for the overall development of women.

- 5) Providing computer education and training, conducting tuition classes for student development.

- 6) To open employment oriented training centers for all-round development and impart various types of training in such training centers and issue related publications as well as conduct lectures and lectures.

- 7) To make education awareness activities for every citizen to be educated and to make efforts to make every citizen to be educated and learn. Providing addiction and superstition oriented education and opening centers for adult education.

- 8) Conducting seminars and programs for educational promotion and issuing publications. To conduct walking tours, cycle tours and adventure tours for educational enhancement, also to organize foreign tours within the limits of the trust.

- 9) To encourage students and promote education by providing assistance to students in the form of books, scholarships, free assistance for higher studies and carrying out educational activities within the limits of the trust.

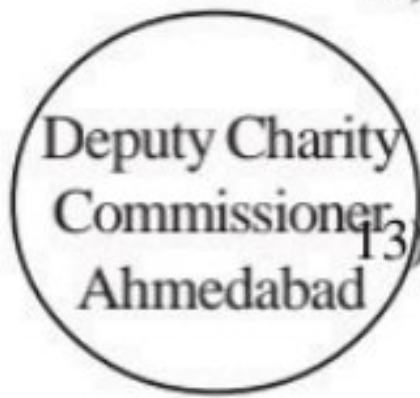
- 10) To establish, run and maintain libraries and magazines, to run and conduct related activities for the overall development of students.

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11) This organization will organize and conduct knowledge camps, lectures, lectures and gatherings for the purpose of propagation of knowledge.

12) To establish, operate and maintain sports centers and health centers for promotion of sports activities, to develop modern equipments for sports and physical development and to teach them to use them scientifically.

13) To start, manage and maintain girls' schools, schools, women's colleges for the education of girls. To carry out activities for the welfare of orphans or aged women, exploited girls, widows, abandoned, destitute women etc. 15) To establish, operate and maintain activities related to the problems of old age and public welfare as well as old aged through Said Institution.

(b) Social Purposes :-

- 1) Without any discrimination of caste, religion, caste, etc., it will try to remove the social problems of the people coming under the trust's scope.
- 2) Efforts will be made to remove the evils and evildoers in the society, and the economic level of the people will rise and all classes will be economically viable.
- 3) Constructing Hall, Dharamshala, Well, Havada, Water Parbo etc.
- 4) To guide, conduct ceremonies, establish, run and maintain meditation centers for social upliftment.
- 5) Getting self-employment opportunities run by the government as an initiative of the trust and making the people of the society aware of it.
- 6) Social activity i.e. the problems arising at the time of final action and death will be remedied by Said Institute.

(c) Health and medical purposes:-

- 1) Conducting health diagnosis camps, conducting blood donation activities, making arrangements for medical treatment at concessional rates. It will also conduct a campaign to eradicate polio.
- 2) To establish, operate and maintain dispensaries, hospitals, nursing homes, consulting rooms, laboratories, health centres, etc. for the maintenance of public health or to assist and promote such services and to provide the public with the facility of ambulance vans within the limits of the trust.
- 3) Conducting activities for medical treatment and sanitation as well as disease awareness.

(d) Cultural purposes:-

- 1) To organize conventions, lectures, seminars, camps, lectures, ceremonies etc. in accordance with the objectives of the organization and to organize lectures, lectures, recitation weeks etc. for the spiritual upliftment of the society.
- 2) Organizing Oratory Competition, Essay Competition, Art, Science fair for all round development.
- 3) To undertake youth and women upliftment activities. Youth Knowledge, science, art, craft, literature, culture etc. to conduct international level knowledge camps with the citizens of the country and abroad and to make efforts to bring the youth forward.

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E) Objectives of Women and Child Development:-

- 1) Will try to improve the standard of living of women in the society. From the Ministry of Women and Child Development will do the activity. Helping widows, destitute women.
- 2) Will and conduct programs like Self Help Group and Self Empowerment for women.
- 3) Providing training in various skill industries like computer, sewing classes, Bharat-Knitting, shorthand etc. in the field of handicrafts.
- 4) Will prevent child marriage, labor and child development activities like proper guidance of children, early childhood education, children's temples and kindergartens.
- 5) To undertake various projects to remove problems like orphans, child nutrition and to organize elocution competitions, cultural programs for the physical and mental development of children and women. To open and maintain centers providing employment oriented vocational training to needy children, youth, women, educated unemployed. It will do activities to boost family planning activities.
- 6) National Women's Day will celebrate the national birthday and benefit various schemes of the government.

(F) Purposes for natural and man-made calamities:-

- 1) In the event of natural or man-made calamities such as epidemics, floods, earthquakes, droughts or wars, necessary assistance will be provided to the victims without discrimination of any kind.
- 2) To help the victims of natural calamities such as natural disasters, fire, heavy rains, etc. or to help the victims and to provide food grains, clothing and other assistance to the needy persons.
- 3) Provide fodder and fodder to animals during natural disasters like famine, heavy rains. To make arrangements for pastures, mines, medicine and kettles etc. for Abol animals like cows, buffaloes etc. within the limits of the trust.

(g) Objectives of Rural Development :

- 1) Provide necessary assistance at the village level and undertake all activities related to village development with the help of State Government, Central Government and Municipal Corporation, Municipalities, World Bank, National Banks and Agricultural Banks and Co-operative Banks.
- 2) To organize the schemes awarded by the Board Corporation. Executing plans. To carry out all activities for construction, construction, construction of watersheds, water projects, water supply projects for rural development, provision of drinking water to people for agricultural development, construction, construction of watersheds, checkdams, ponds, canals, watersheds, checkdams, ponds, canals, water storage.
- 3) To carry out all activities to undertake the activities of providing drinking water in urban and rural areas and to present the related projects to the Government.

(H) Environmental and sanitation purposes

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- 1) To take and make all efforts to prevent and preserve the increasing environmental damage.
- 2) To undertake tree plantation activities, protection of trees, advice on planting and growing trees and related activities. Carrying out pollution removal activities.
- 3) This organization will undertake works like roads, water works on waste disposal with government, semi-government organization, corporations, local bodies.
- 4) To carry out and implement sanitation programs run through the Village Development Agency and the Ministry of Rural Development and to receive and run from the Government or other agencies.
- 5) To maintain the environment more trees camps and nurseries and to conduct intensive programs of the Ministry of Forests. To carry out activities to maintain cleanliness in the cities of the entire state of Gujarat.
- 6) This organization shall carry out, arrange or establish and run all the activities provided by Government, Semi-Government, Corporations, Departments, Local Bodies, Private Bodies, Village Development Organisations, Gram Panchayats and other bodies and various Departments, Departments.

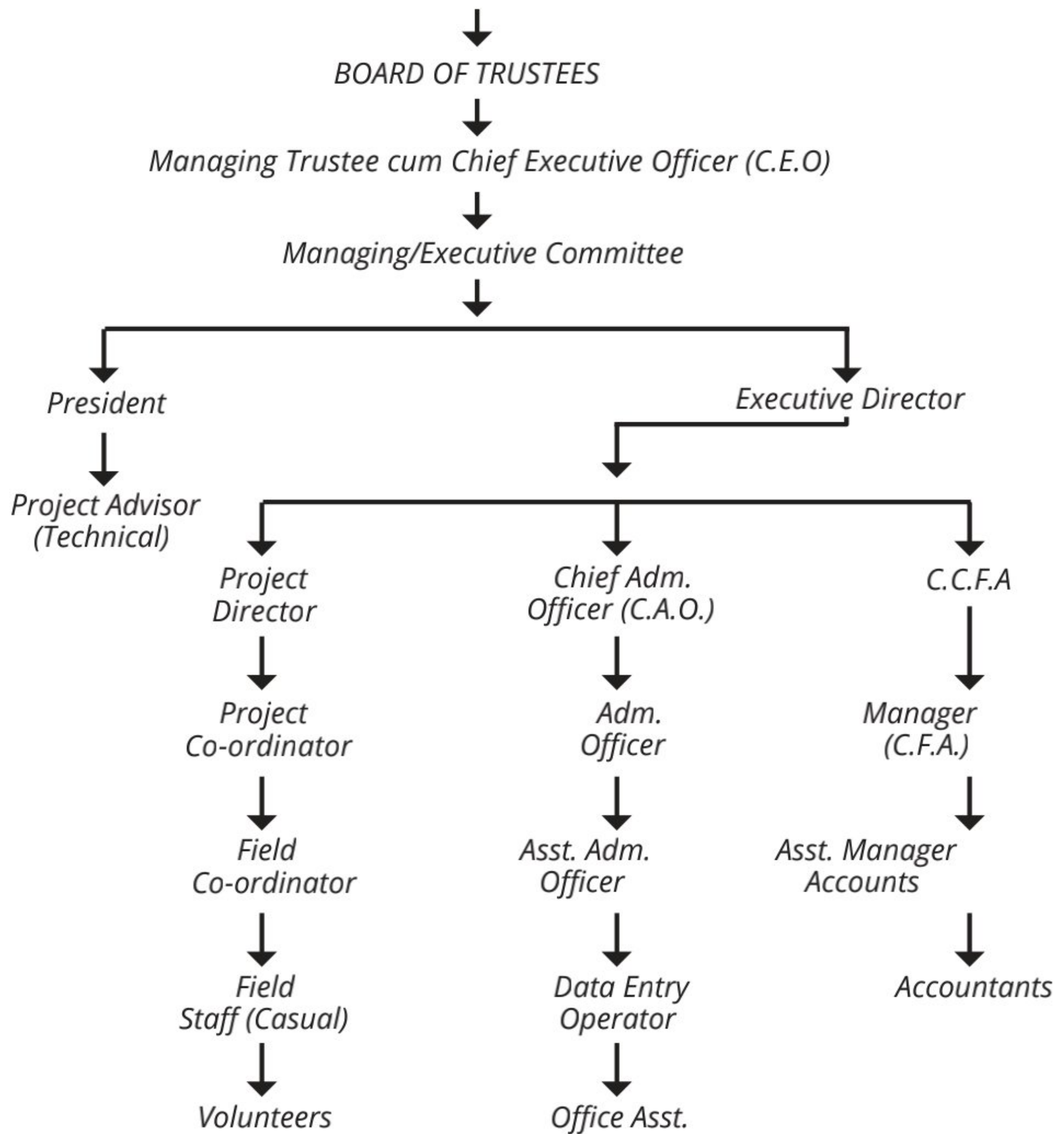

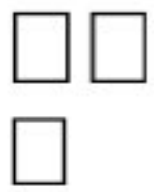
